



Neonatal resuscitation training

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Statement of the standard

Every healthcare professional is given access to and undertakes regular neonatal resuscitation training.



For parents and family

- Parents and families are informed by healthcare professionals about neonatal resuscitation training and have an opportunity for resuscitation training before discharge.
- Parents are encouraged and enabled to be present with their infant during resuscitation, as part of a family-centred approach.



For neonatal unit

Recertification evidence is regularly audited.



For hospital

Training in resuscitation is mandatory.

Benefits

Short-term benefits

- Improved survival at birth following perinatal compromise requiring resuscitation

Long-term benefits

- Improved long-term outcomes with timely and effective resuscitation



For healthcare professionals

Training in resuscitation using the European guidelines is attended by all responsible physicians, nurses and midwives.
